Dear Sirs:

The board and members of Three Ponds Protective Association have recently become aware that the Town is considering permitting ReEnergy to establish a business as a landfill on land located at the Rt. 125 and Rt. 16 (exit 18) interchange perilously close to the Branch River. When first brought before us, this proposal, on its face, was alarming to this association, and seemed poorly considered on many levels in relation to the health of our lakes, watershed, aquifers and Milton's future. We have a great number of questions and wish to be advised on all the particulars of this proposal's long-term environmental impact and what absolute safeguards and guarantees accompany this enterprise.

TPPA's mission and first priority is to protect our lakes, watershed and its environment, as these are the town's greatest assets. So, as an association, we weigh the potentially negative long-term impacts of any proposal against the benefits with consideration to our watershed. Landfills frequently have had negative environmental impacts and we encourage Milton to be very prudent and thorough in its consideration. We hope any proposals, such as this, with potential long-term liabilities to the town and its resources triggers broad reaching discussions with all agencies and associations who have knowledge and interests of impacted regions.

TPPA would like to take part in any further discussions on this proposal and will try to have representatives present at future public meetings regarding this topic. We look forward to learning more details so as to anticipate any adverse consequences there could be to our lakes.
